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TIL TA'LIMIDA PODKAST VA AUDIOKITOBLARNING O'RNI РОЛЬ ПОДКАСТОВ И АУДИОКНИГ В ЯЗЫКОВОМ ОБРАЗОВАНИИ THE ROLE OF PODCASTS AND AUDIOBOOKS IN LANGUAGE EDUCATION

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Annotatsiya

Ushbu tadqiqot podkastlar va audiokitoblarning til ta'limidagi rolini oʻrganib, ularning tinglash va gapirish koʻnikmalariga, soʻz boyligini oʻzlashtirishga va umumiy tilni bilishga ta'sirini ta'kidlaydi. 100 nafar til oʻrganuvchilar bilan aralash usullardan foydalangan holda, tadqiqot ushbu raqamli resurslarning samaradorligini baholash uchun miqdoriy baholash va sifatli intervyulardan foydalanadi. Natijalar podkastlar va audiokitoblardan foydalangan ishtirokchilarda tinglab tushunish, gapirish qobiliyatlari va lugʻatni saqlashda sezilarli yaxshilanishlarni koʻrsatadi. Bundan tashqari, talabalar turli urgʻularni tushunish qiyin boʻlishiga qaramay, motivatsiya va madaniy xabardorlikning ortishi haqida xabar berishdi. Tadqiqot podkastlar va audiokitoblarni til ta'limiga integratsiyalashning pedagogik afzalliklarini ta'kidlab, ulardan foydalanishni optimallashtirish uchun moslashtirilgan strategiyalarni ishlab chiqish zarurligini ta'kidlaydi. Kelajakdagi tadqiqotlar til oʻrganish natijalarini yaxshilash uchun ushbu vositalardan foydalanishning eng yaxshi amaliyotlarini aniqlashqa qaratilishi kerak.

Аннотация
