**Task-Based Language Teaching (TBLT).** Task-Based Language Teaching involves students completing meaningful tasks using the target language. These tasks are designed to reflect real-world activities and require students to use language communicatively and purposefully. Key Characteristics: focus on completing specific tasks rather than on language forms, tasks are designed to be relevant and engaging to students., emphasis on using language naturally and authentically, incorporation of tasks that involve problem-solving, collaboration, and critical thinking. Example: Students might work together to plan a community event, requiring them to negotiate, delegate tasks, and present their plan in English. [2]

**Flipped Classroom Model.** The flipped classroom model reverses traditional teaching by delivering instructional content outside of the classroom (typically online), while class time is used for active learning through discussions, problem-solving, and practical applications. Characteristics: students access lectures, readings, and other materials before class, class time is dedicated to engaging activities that reinforce and apply knowledge, encourages student-centered learning and collaboration. Allows for more personalized instruction and immediate feedback. Example: Students watch a video lecture on English grammar rules at home, then participate in classroom activities that apply these rules through writing exercises and peer review. [3]

**Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL).** CLIL integrates the learning of a language with the learning of other content, such as science, history, or math. This method promotes both language and subject matter proficiency by teaching subjects through the target language. Characteristics: dual-focused educational approach: both content and language objectives are pursued, emphasis on learning language through engaging with subject content, use of subject-specific materials and activities. encourages cognitive development alongside language acquisition. Example: A science lesson might be taught in English, with students conducting experiments, recording observations, and discussing results in the target language. [4]

**Grammar-Translation Method.** The grammar-translation method focuses on teaching grammar rules and vocabulary through translation exercises. This traditional method emphasizes reading and writing, with less focus on speaking and listening skills. Characteristics: heavy emphasis on grammatical rules and vocabulary memorization, use of translation exercises to reinforce language learning, focus on reading and writing rather than oral communication, often involves rote learning and repetition. Example: Students might translate sentences from their native language into English, practicing specific grammar points and vocabulary. [5]
